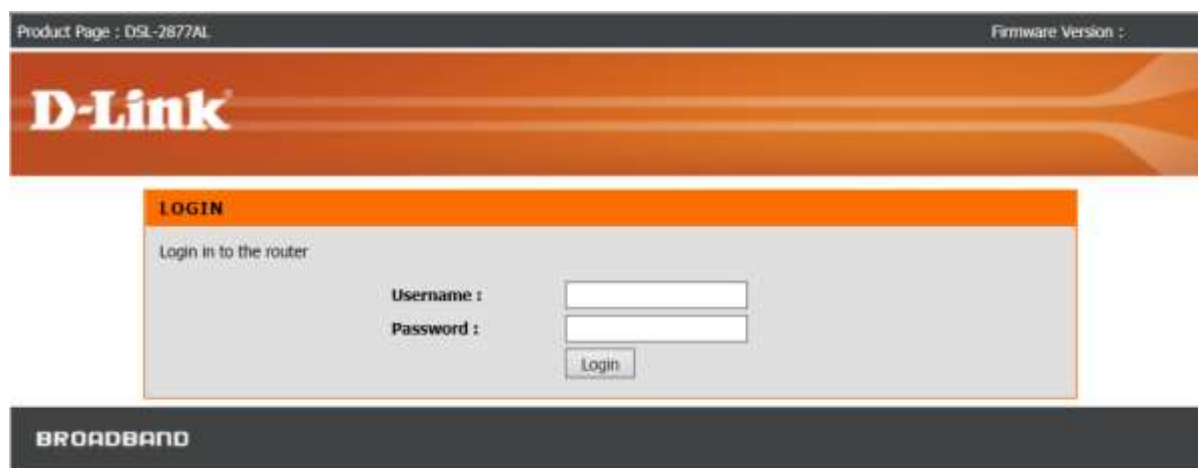
# D-Link® Technical Support Setup Procedure

ขั้นตอนที่ 1 : เปิดเว็บเบราว์เซอร์ของคุณ แล้วพิมพ์ <http://192.168.1.1> ในช่องของ Address Bar

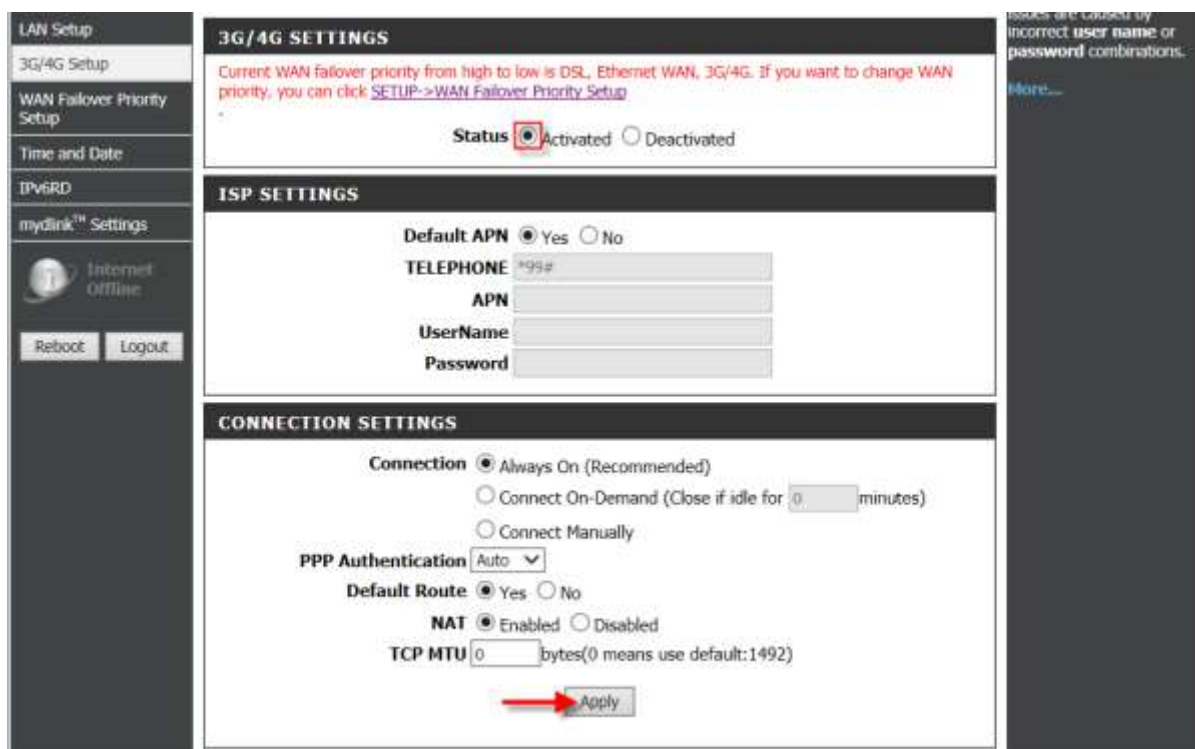

ขั้นตอนที่ 3 : เลือก Status เป็น Activated

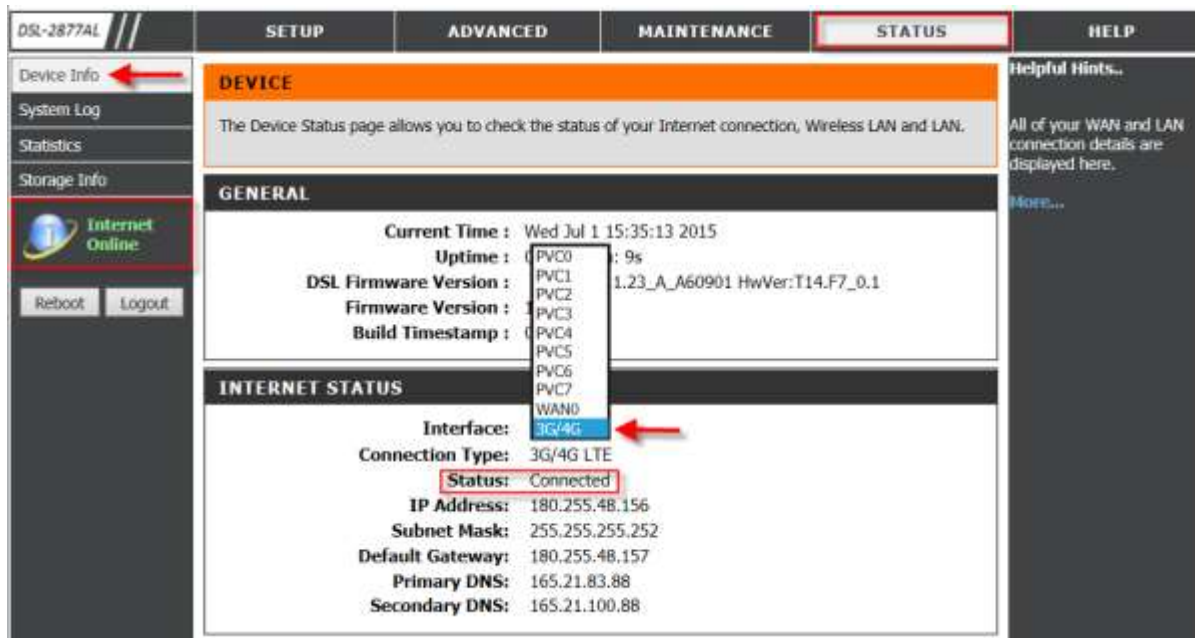

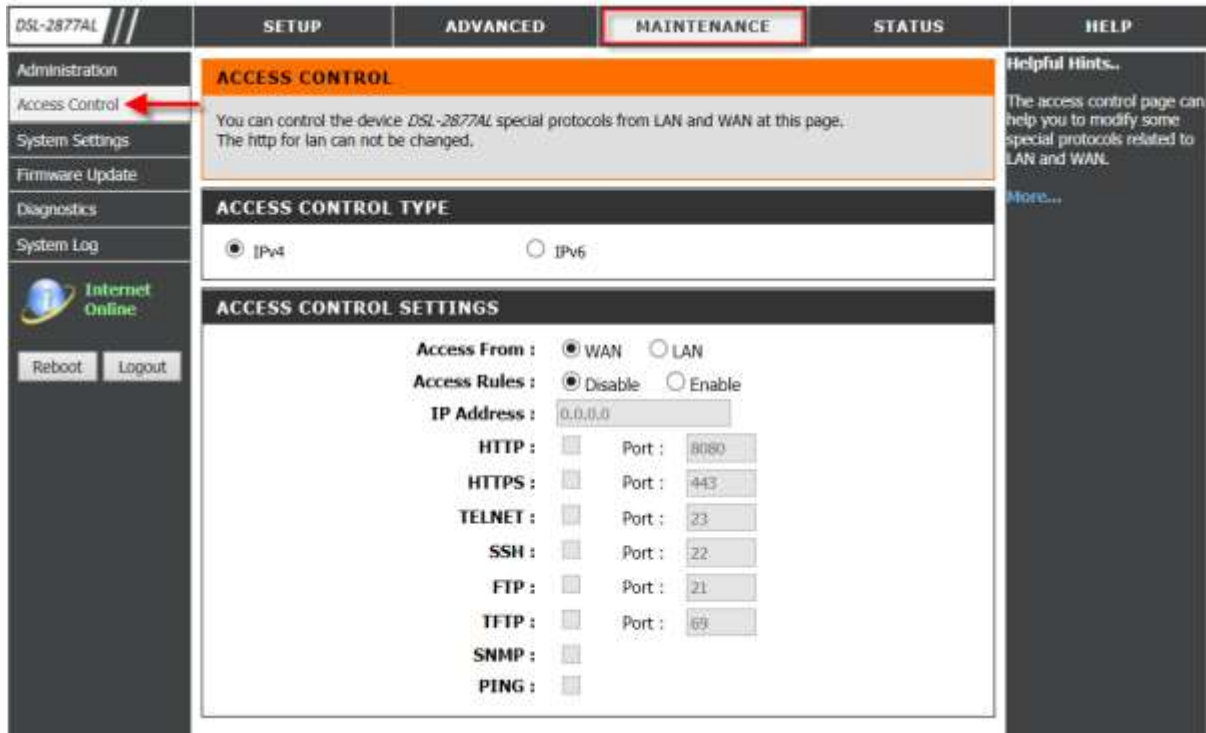

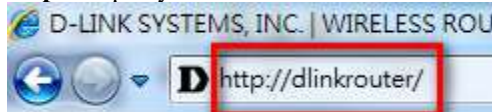

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- **How do I configure USB Modem Dongle connection to my router?**

**Step 1:** Open your Internet browser and enter <http://192.168.1.1> into the address bar.



Enter your login information. If you have not changed the default settings, the

- **Username** field is Admin and
- **Password** field should Admin. Click **Login**.



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**Step 2:** Click the **Setup** tab at the top of the page and then click **3G/4G Setup** from the menu on the left-hand side.
